"The Verification Industry"



Weekly Learnings 40 / 2025

You should read this if you are applying to a company that is conducting a verification check on you.

I met Ravishankar Panchanathan, the CEO of Matrix Business Services India Private Limited

They are in the Verification industry, a fascinating field that serves as a leading indicator of many things.

Here's what I learnt

- 1. 6 international companies do this, and many, many Indian companies do this with price as their only variable.
- 2. This industry works on credibility, speed of verification, and price.
- 3. The white-collar industry did 500k verifications per month before; now that's dropped to about 320k per month. So, hiring is down, a lead indicator.
- 4. The big sectors they serve are banks, IT services, and BPO. Banks are the strictest in terms of verification.
- 5. This verification is crucial for the first jobber and the second jobber.
- 6. The first level of verification is Aadhar, PAN card, PF, criminal case check, and location. Location is a funny one in a world of migration and shifting apartments. The candidate needs a picture in front of his/her residence. I can understand a location check for a passport, not for these jobs.

- 7. The second level of verification is academic qualifications, via Digi locker. Some recruiters insist on a university certificate or clearance, and here's where many verification companies do the wrong thing by having rubber stamps of universities with them for speed money.
- 8. The third level of check is physical for drugs, where they take your blood sample.
- 9. 5 to 7 pc of candidates fail the verification test; that's a large number, and the cost runs into crores.
- 10. In the past, the industry did verification after selection; now they are doing it earlier at the screening stage.

This industry looks to move to skill-based checks in the future with innovative companies.

Low-level verification is done for Uber and Zomato.

All digital checks are expected in 24 hours, and physical checks in 15 days currently.
