The mumbai dabbawallahs valued time decades ago. Ajay Kaul and his team pioneered 30 minutes or your money back with Dominos.

Time is about instant gratification vs delayed gratification. Children want instant gratification and now most adults want it too. Time is impacting place in the marketing mix, for many QSR brands the delivery to.home business is bigger than the fine in in outlet business!

It's the emotional side of time that I believe is gaining ground.

Kodak tried for years with their photo labs and 1 day delivery and evening delivery. Photography never too off. Arrive the mobile phone with social media and suddenly everyone is taking pictures since it's convenient time and no cost time.

We are getting to a similar point overall. Income Tax claims settled in 15 minutes by the government, Ride sharing when you decide etc.

The rational side of time will always be about performance.


Time as an element of driving instant gratification has arrived in India with its delivery models, better infrastructure, low mobile data costs and cheap delivery labor costs.


